

ENNIS A&M CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Ennis A&M Club Scholarship is \$1000 awarded to a high school student graduating from an Ennis, TX School and entering Texas A&M University at College Station, Texas (Blinn team is not acceptable). The scholarship recipient is selected by the officers of the Ennis A&M Club and announced at the Ennis Aggie Muster on April 21st of each year. Payment is \$500 per your first two semesters of study. Prior to receiving the second semester payment, the recipient must have a first semester grade point ratio of at least 2.0 and must furnish a copy of first semester grades to the Treasurer of the Ennis A&M Club. If a first semester 2.0 GPR was not achieved, the recipient may forfeit the second semester payment.
